


2025 WORLD OCEANS DAY ART CONTEST!



- Entries are limited to one per child. Multiple entries will not be accepted.
- Entries should be the size of an 8.5” x 11” (22cm x 28cm) sheet of paper.
- All entries must be entrant’s own original artwork. Digitally created entries will be accepted with the exception of artwork using other artists’ works and/or AI imaging.
- All submissions must include the following information: Student’s name and grade, contact email address, school name, and town/city. The student’s name and grade should be used as the file name of the attachment.
- For privacy reasons, entries must not include images of the artist, only the artwork.
- Entries must be saved digitally and emailed by May 9, 2025 to: WORLDOCEANSDAY@GOV.NL.CA
- Entries must not include the entrant’s information directly on the artwork. All entrants’ information should be included in the email.
- Winners and honourable mentions will be decided by a panel from the World Oceans Day NL Committee.
- Notification of winners: Winners will be announced on the World Oceans Day Facebook page on June 8 and a follow-up notification will be sent via contact information provided in entry email. Except where prohibited, acceptance of a prize constitutes the winner’s consent to the use of their name, grade, and artwork for advertising and promotional purposes by the World Oceans Day NL Committee without limitation and without additional compensation.
- The World Oceans Day NL Committee retains the right to publish, use, adapt, edit, and/or modify contest entries in any way, in any and all media, for commercial or non-commercial use, without limitation and without additional compensation, except where prohibited by law.
